- Ensure packaged materials are up to quality standards.
- Discard any products that are incorrectly packaged or damaged in specified rework bins.
- Apply approved methods, package the finished goods neatly into storage units such as trays, cartons etc.
- Lift trays and packaged goods onto skid.
- Assemble the cardboard trays, ensuring they are done according to specifications.
- Using pump trucks, transport pallets of packaged goods to specified areas within the warehouse for shipping.
- Ensure housekeeping is maintained on a daily basis.
- At the end of shift ensure all machinery parts are cleaned as per Company specifications.
- Work safely and ensure health and safety is of paramount importance.
- Conduct monthly inventory required by Production Manager.
- Assist with material handling (bring raw materials to production area).
- Assist in any area as required by the Production Manager.
- Adhere to GMP and GDP practices.
- Adhere to all Food Safety and QA practices.
